MESSAGE FROM CHIEF

(CONTINUATION)

At Aamro Aviation, we believe that every safe flight begins well before the engine starts. Thorough preflight planning and a complete aircraft walk-around aren't just required steps — they are essential habits that separate disciplined aviators from the rest. Reviewing weather, NOTAMs, weight and balance, fuel planning, and alternate routes builds situational awareness and confidence. It also prepares you to make smart decisions when things don't go exactly as planned — and in aviation, that's often the case. These moments of preparation aren't just paperwork; they are the first line of defense in ensuring a safe, smooth flight.

Equally important is the physical inspection of your aircraft. The preflight walk-around is your opportunity to become familiar with the condition of the machine you're trusting with your life. Look beyond the checklist — check for fuel quality, signs of wear, missing fasteners, and anything that seems out of place. Don't be lazy! Get on the ground and look at the belly for signs of oil leaks, gas leaks, popped rivets etc. Never assume someone else "already looked at it." Whether you're a student on your first solo or a CFI flying a back-to-back schedule, treat every aircraft with the respect it deserves. At Aamro, we train with modern aircraft equipped with Garmin G1000 avionics, but even the most advanced systems can't replace a watchful eye and a careful mindset on the ground.
