As a flight instructor at Aamro Aviation, I've had some unforgettable experiences in the cockpit—but nothing quite like the journey I recently completed. I was part of a delivery team flying three brand-new Piper Archer DX aircraft from Lakeland, Florida all the way to a flight school in Ahmedabad, India. Over the course of 6 days we flew from Florida to Virginia, Maine, and then up through Canada, Greenland, and Iceland. From there, we continued through Scotland, Germany, Croatia, Greece, Egypt, Saudi Arabia, Oman, and finally landed in India. And just to make it more interesting—none of our planes had autopilot. Every mile was hand-flown. Along the way, we saw things I never imagined I'd witness from the cockpit of a general aviation airplane. Flying low over the glaciers and icebergs between Greenland and Iceland felt like stepping into another world. I'll never forget the moment we passed over

the Great Pyramids of Egypt, circling to take in the view of one of humanity's greatest wonders from just a few thousand feet above. Each leg of the journey offered a new challenge, whether it was managing long over-water stretches, navigating unfamiliar airspace, or simply staying sharp for hours on end. For our students here at Aamro Aviation, I want this story to be more than just a cool tale—it's a reminder of what's possible when you dedicate yourself to being the best pilot you can be. Your training today is laying the foundation for future adventures you can't even imagine yet. Whether you're preparing for your first solo or your commercial checkride, fly with discipline, curiosity, and passion.
